1 See Christ as the image of the invisible God.

Jesus makes the unseen God known. Before everything we can see, Christ already was, and all God's fullness dwells in Him.
Colossians 1:15, 19; John 1:1-3, 18; Hebrews 1:3

2 Let Christ hold the center of every part of life.

All things were created through Him and for Him. He does not fit into our plans; our plans, priorities, and identity find their order in Him.

3 Trust the King who reconciles through His cross.
