Acts 1:4-8 | Pastor Lee Kilpatrick

1 Wait for the promise before you go.

Jesus told eyewitnesses of the resurrection to stay put. Sometimes obedience looks like waiting for what only the Father can give.

Acts 1:4-5; Luke 24:49; Psalm 27:14

2 Trade your timetable for His mission.

They asked for a date; He gave them a commission. What the Father holds in His own authority is not ours to manage.

Acts 1:6-7; Matthew 24:36; Proverbs 16:9

3 Receive power, then be a witness.

The Spirit does not come to make us comfortable but to make us witnesses - starting at home and reaching the ends of the earth.

Acts 1:8; Luke 24:48; Isaiah 43:10
